- 8) New Business:

- a. DISCUSSION ITEM: Civic Engagement Week / Ballot Bowl (A. Reyes)
 - i. Debuted new logo and marketing designs for Civic Engagement Week. Explained how the competition depends on the use of a specific link. A signup sheet was passed out for tabling events for that week. Shared which elected officials have responded to the invites. Introduced possible carnival games for Constitution Day Carnival. Also shared that the League of Women Voters will be attending next Senate meeting to train the Senate on how to register students.
- b. ACTION ITEM: Appointment of Director of External Affairs (A. Reyes)
 - i. M/S/P (B. Sanchez/A. Christopher) Motion passed 7-0-0
- c. DISCUSSION ITEM: Passing Bills / Resolutions (R. Perez)
 - i. Explanation on how to pass bills and resolutions in the Senate, and stressed the importance of passing legislation in this body. Discussion of possible incentives for passing legislation. Also shared that the Judicial branch will assist senators in the formatting and procedures of crafting legislation.
- d. DISCUSSION ITEM: Ekho Halloween Party (T. Chase)
 - i. Shared that Ekho will be having a Halloween themed event October 29th from 5-7pm, and ASI entities are invited to participate. There will be a scavenger hunt that may require students to visit entity offices. Possible opportunities for tabling were discussed.
- e. Discussion ITEM: Senior Class Gift (A. Reyes)
 - i. Shared with the Senate that University Advancement is interested in creating a philanthropic culture on campus with the possibility of a senior class gift. Discussion about the gifts purpose focused on either the Hot Meals Program or the Dolphin Pantry; discussion seemed to favor the Dolphin Pantry. Also, a discussion on possible incentives for seniors who donate ranged from: discounts on graduation caps, gowns, or stools; a free or special designated tassel; permanent recognition on campus; creation of an event to recognize students; incorporation of awarding students at the Legacy/Maximus Awards night; helping fund the travel and hotel stay of parents who struggle to afford the costs of simply attending the graduation; and possibly priority seating at graduation for families of students who donate.
