



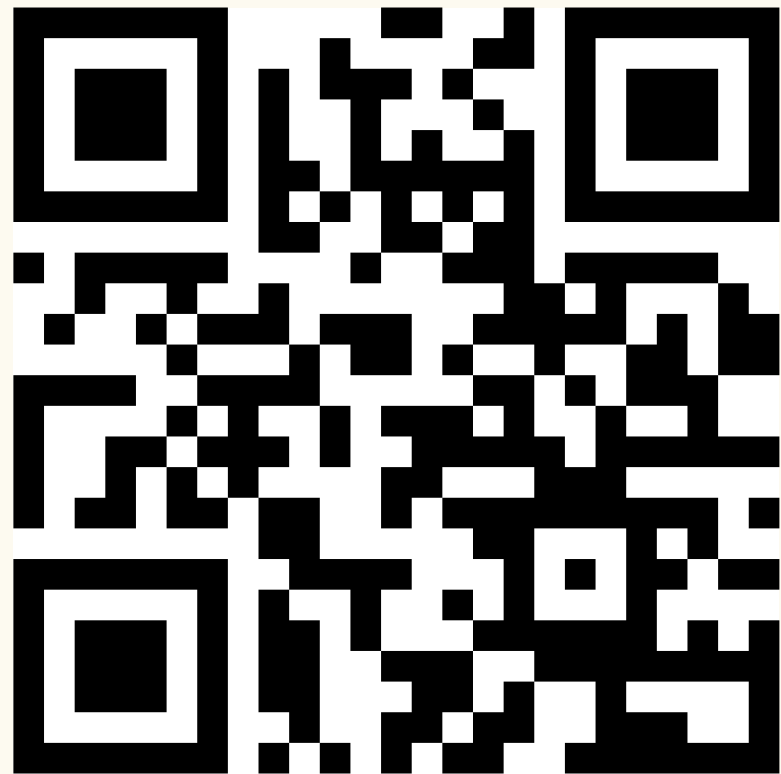
President's Report
