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## Takeaways 9/12

#### Senate 1st and 2nd Readings

- First Senate Meeting: waived first reading of "log form" for two academic program
- Concerns were shared that their colleagues were not given the chance to bring the programs back to their unit and gather feedback
- The waiver limited Senate's role in the review of these new proposed academic programs, and it squandered an opportunity for Senate to explore and understand its role in the approval in the approval process for academic programs
- When programs come for approval, Senate sould: pay attention to the important issues that aren't part of curriculum development process, resource needs, the demand for graduates, opportunity costs, benefits of approving the program, other high-level questions

 Senate Chair will ask President and Provost to limit any communication with the public (press releases) about new programs until they have received Senate approval
