Current All Gender Restroom Requirements

- 1. In 2017 the Division of the State Architect's office created All Gender Restroom designation.
- Applies to single occupant Restrooms only.
- 3. Multiple occupant restrooms were not covered under the new requirement.

BULLETIN: IDENTIFICATION OF SINGLE-USER TOILET FACILITIES AS ALL-GENDER: FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



PURPOSE: This bulletin is a supplement to *BU 17-01: Identification of Single-User Toilet Facilities as All-Gender* and is provided to assist facility operators and design professionals who design facilities under the jurisdiction of DSA in interpreting the requirements of Health and Safety Code (HSC) 118600.

DISCUSSION: HSC 118600 requires:

- a) All single-user toilet facilities in any business establishment, place of public accommodation, or state or local government agency shall be identified as all-gender toilet facilities by signage that complies with Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations, and designated for use by no more than one occupant at a time or for family or assisted use.
- b) During any inspection of a business or a place of public accommodation by an inspector, building official, or other local official responsible for code enforcement, the inspector or official may inspect for compliance with this section.
- c) For the purposes of this section, "single-user toilet facility" means a toilet facility with no more than one water closet and one urinal with a locking mechanism controlled by the user.
- d) This section shall become operative on March 1, 2017.

Current All Gender Restrooms



All Gender Restroom Upgrades

- 1. Upgrades would primarily only require new restroom signage.
- 2. Addition work may require adjusted/replaced urinal partitions to increase privacy.
- 3. Mirrors may need to be removed or adjusted to increase privacy.






Proposed Multiple Occupant All Gender Restroom Costs

•	Approximate	Costs
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	Approximate Costs	
	 Door signs (per sign): 	\$100
	 Latch Signs (per sign): 	\$250 to \$350
	 Additional Wayfinding Signs (per sign): 	\$300 to \$400
•	Total Approximate Phase 1 Signage Costs:	\$11,000
•	Urinal Partition and Mirror Modifications:	\$4,000
•	Misc. Labor & Installation:	\$3,000
•	Total Phase 1 Approximate Costs:	\$18,000




Current Lactation Rooms



Lactation Room Requirements


- Completely private with lockable door.
- 2. Soft furniture. Must be easily cleaned.
- 3. Sink to clean equipment.
- 4. Power outlet easy to access.
- 5. Small refrigerator.
- 6. Hard surface flooring recommended.
- 7. CANNOT be in an existing restroom.
