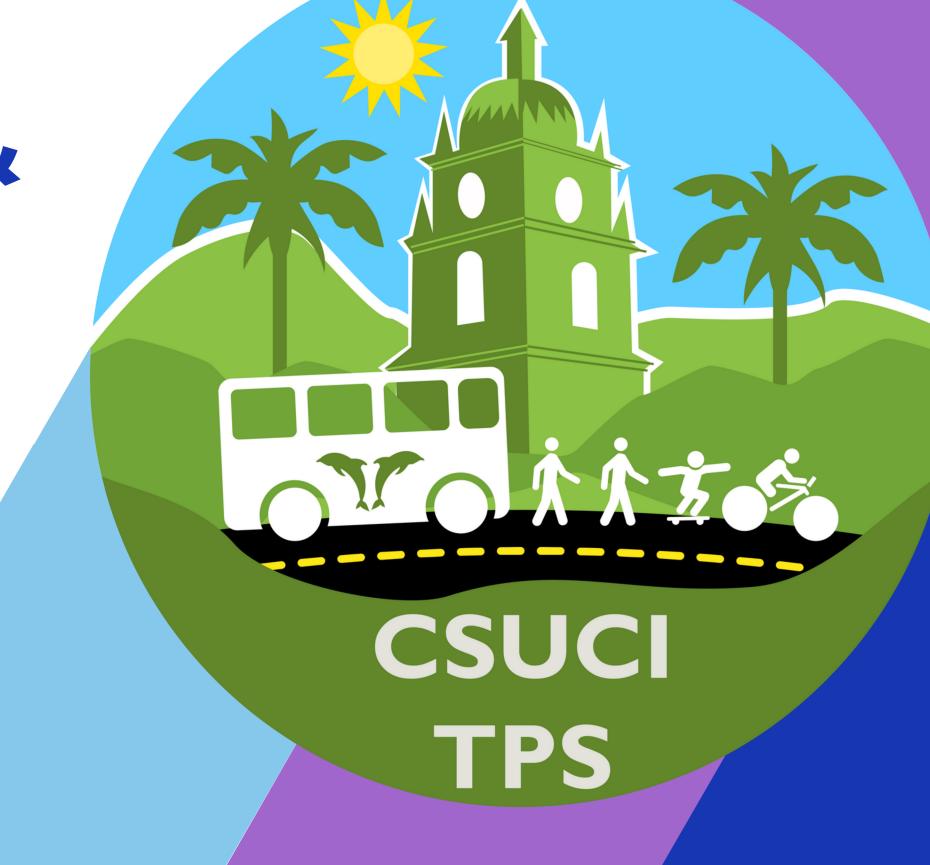

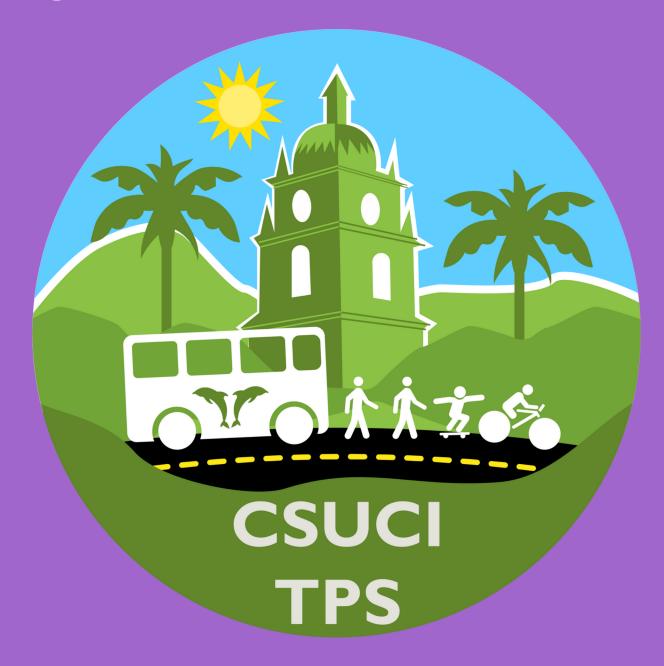

#### **University Auxiliary**

- We are a self-funded auxiliary department of the University
- We receive NO money from the state general fund

#### How are we funded?

 All of our operational costs are covered with revenues from the sales of parking permits on campus

# Why does the student parking permit cost \$195.00 per semester?

Cost of a parking permit is determined by the amount of revenue required to cover all department operational costs.

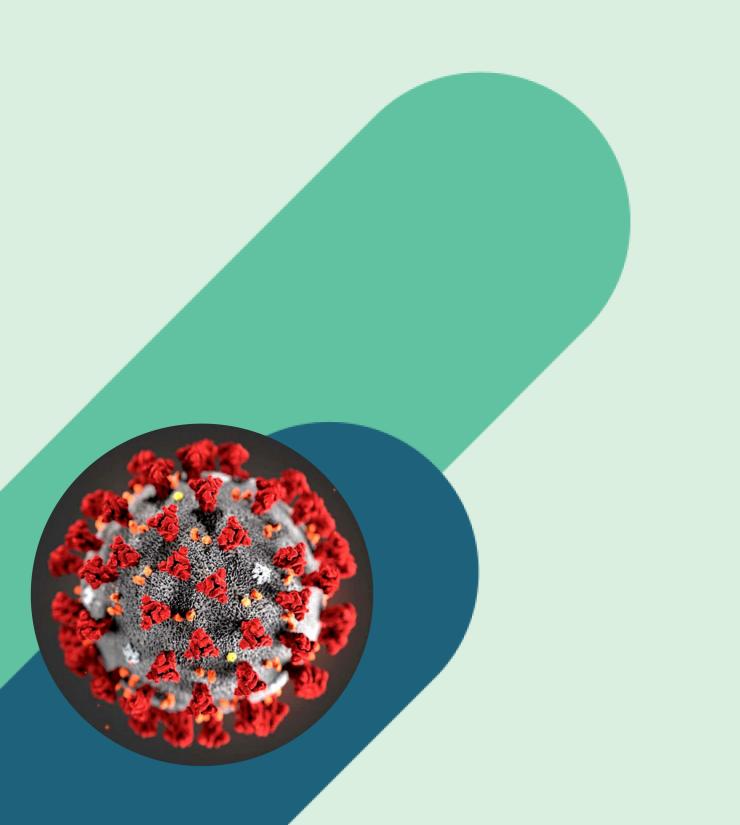

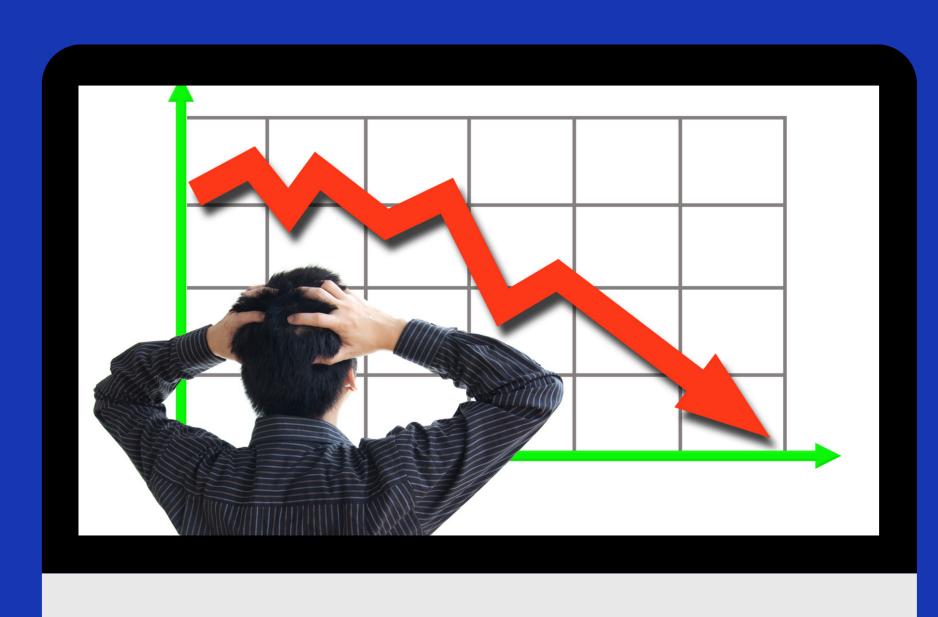

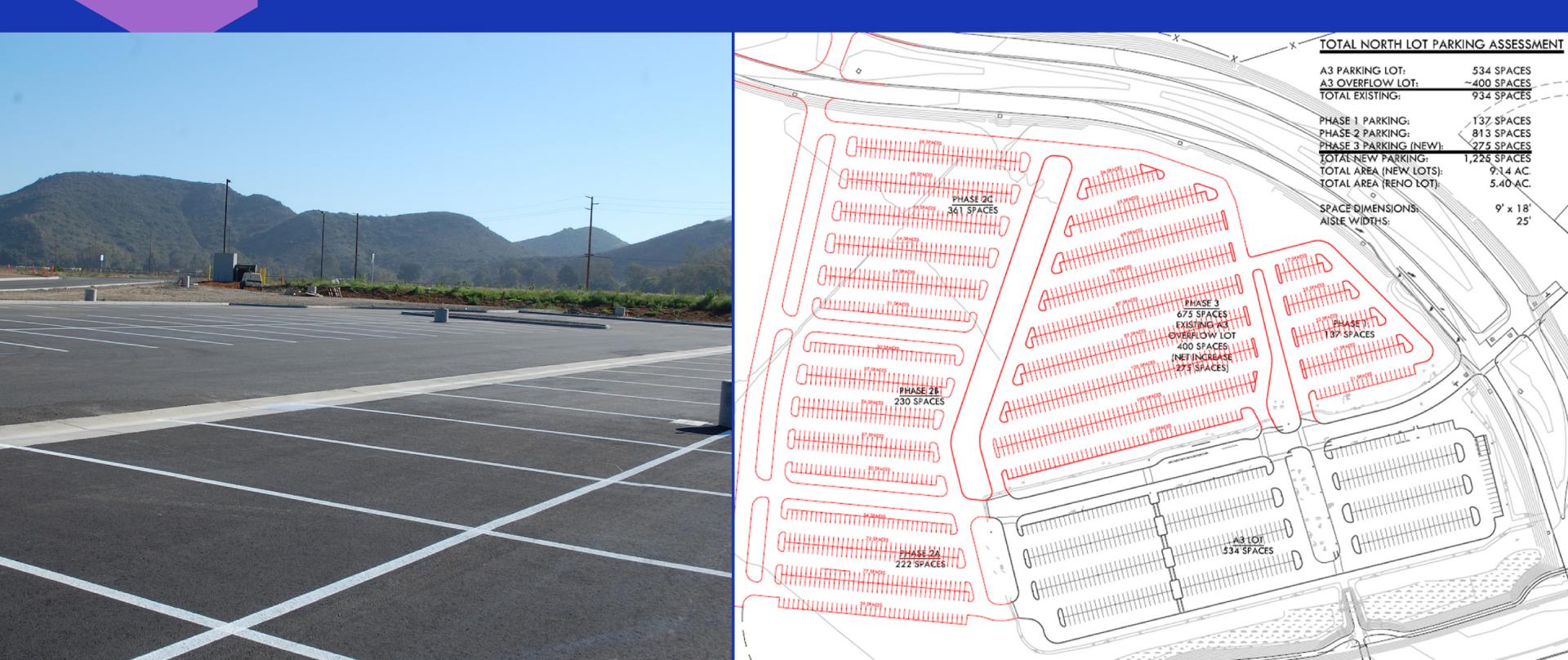
