AB 1655: STATE HOLIDAYS: JUNETEENTH

- Establishes June 19th as a paid state holiday to commemorate the end of slavery in the United States.
- Provides that employees scheduled to work on the observed Juneteenth date receive a paid day off or holiday pay.
- Notes:
 - On June 17, 2021, President Biden signed the Juneteenth National Independence Day Act into law, establishing June 19th as a federal holiday and making it the first federal holiday since the establishment of Martin Luther King Jr. Day in 1983.
