Background

Early Alert System	Student Success intervention, involves faculty identifying students, and connecting students to campus resources
Success & Retention	Early Alerts may provide a sense of connection, feel that the institution care about them and their success, eliminate perceived evaluator bias, increase motivation and preserve a student's identification with a domain (CSUN)
DFW	"D" & "F" as in letter grades, and "W" as in Withdraw
Aligns with CSU's Goals	CSU identified five equity goals and priorities to address the gap, including: Promote Equitable Learning and Reduce DFW Rates
Aligns with Mission of CSUCI	Placing students at the center of their educational experience
Aligns with Mission & Purpose of Academic Senate	One of Academic Senate's purpose is to promote academic excellence at this University (Senate Constitution-2022)

EAS Defined

EAS can serve as a campus wide student success intervention that:

1. Involves faculty identifying students with student behaviors or performance impacting their academic progress
2. Connects students with campus support (Academic Advisors, EOP, LRC, WMC, peer mentors etc)

Purpose:

To address student success and retention, and encourage the implementation of an Early Alert System at California State University Channel Islands with the implementation of an Early Alert System Task Force.

Resolution:

WHEREAS an Early Alert System (EAS) is a campus wide student success intervention that involves faculty identifying students with student behaviors i.e. absenteeism, mental health disparities, or low involvement in class/schoolwork or performance impacting the academic progress and connecting students with campus support (Academic Advisors, EOP, LBC, W/C, peer mentors, etc.)

WHEREAS CSU Channel Islands has not implemented a campus wide Early Alert System

WHEREAS the CSU aims to close the equity gap by promoting equitable learning and reducing DFW rates¹

WHEREAS the CSU has seen the adoption of similar programs and systems at the following campuses: CSUN², CSULB³, and CSUMB⁴
