- 5) Public Forum:

a. *A. Rugerio:* A moment of silence was held for Osamuyi Jeremy Ighodaro, an influential Dolphin on campus who was a strong presence in the Black Student Union. Their funeral will be held on October 14, starting at 9:00am at the Church of the Hills at Forest Lawn in Hollywood Hills. Students are encouraged to read the Campus Global email that was sent out on October 12, and cards can be delivered to the Dean of Students office by the end of day on October 13.

- a. Legislative Reports:
 - *i.* Senator of Student Engagement (J. Guajardo)
 - Held their office hour with Russell Winans on October 11 to talk about CISyncall new students who enrolled prior to June of 2021 automatically had an account created for them. Winans also updated the student demographics data to show their class standing to help club leaders accommodate their members.
 - 2. Held their one-on-one with Vice President Ramprasad to potentially expand outreach efforts and contact with the mentor programs on campus.

 - Attended the ASI Board of Directors meeting on October 7 where they assigned members to the two committees of the board and President Rugerio will be serving on the Budget Allocation and Spending Committee (which looks into how money is being allocated and spent within all of ASI). The CSU is looking for a new President for Channel Islands, and an open forum was October 12 12:00pm-2:00pm where students, staff, faculty, and community members were invited to share what qualities they want the new president to have. The deadline to submit a feedback form so it can be incorporated with the job description is October 21;




• Met with Dr.Yao and Celina Zacarias




