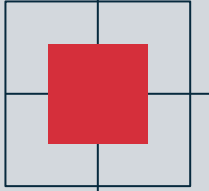

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# Multi-Year Tuition Increase Proposal

As included in CSSA's Meeting Minutes for July

<b>BOARD ACTION</b>	September 2023, that would put in place scheduled tuition rate increase each year
<b>EFFECTIVE BY</b>	Increases would begin in Fall 2024
<b>INCREASE</b>	Annual rate increase would be 6% per year for all levels of education
<b>FIRST INCREASE</b>	Would be \$342 for academic year for full-time undergraduate students
<b>IMPACT</b>	Proposal states, "Sixty percent of students would not be affected by the proposed tuition increase because their tuition is fully covered by grants or waivers"
<b>BOT REVIEW</b>	Board of Trustees would review the tuition rate schedule every five years

The Board resolution authorizing this fee requires that whenever the Board takes action to adjust tuition for graduate students, the same adjustment will be made to the Graduate Business Professional Fee. The following table shows the per semester and per quarter unit rates. Revenue from Graduate Business Professional Fee varies widely by campus and is kept locally at each campus to educate graduate students.

# Background

## June

President & VP were informed of 3 initial proposals, CSSA confirmed CO choice for which proposal to present to BOT

## July

President & VP attended CSSA Plenary, BOD voted unanimously (23-0) to oppose the proposal

## August

Attended CSUnity where more time was dedicated to advocacy effort planning, wrote cards for CSSA to deliver to BOT

## September

Board of Trustees plans to vote on proposal during BOT meeting, opportunity for public comment, SG President will attend

## Fall 2024

If approved, this is when the first tuition increase would take effect

## 2029

If approved, this is when the tuition increase will be reviewed, not enough details on what this would look like

Discussion provided by President Navarrete during July

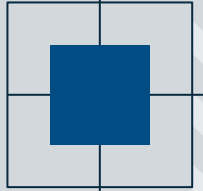
## State Grants / Financial Aid

1st Question, included the hypocrisy stated by one of the presenters. During their presentation they stated that State Grants & Awards would match all tuition increases, however the tuition proposal they provided us stated that there is no guarantee of this at all, the presenter acknowledged that this was a mistake on their behalf and that they cannot / should not have spoken on behalf of State Grants & Awards.

## Working More

President cited that the proposal compares the tuition increase to only “working 0.4 to 1.2 more hours a week”

President expressed this not an option available to all students who do not have the same privilege to work, such as Undocumented Students.
