Safe (Overnight) Parking Presented to Student Government Senate Shared During University Police Advisory Council Meeting

Safe Parking:

- Designated parking lots where students can legally park and sleep in their cars overnight Reasons:
 - This would reduce the financial strain on commuter students having to pay for gas for long travel distances, and it would also prevent long-term wear and tear on their cars, which can also accumulate larger financial burdens down the road

Would Serve the Following Students:

- This is not specifically addressing students who are unhoused; it is to allow commuter students a safe spot to park and be able to attend their courses without the long travel times
- Students could be required to provide documentation that they have an active address; if they do not, then Basic Needs is the designated department that can provide emergency housing and address the students' needs

Implement as a pilot program:

- Would require:
 - Time curfews that require students to check in and check out by certain times
 - Access to a restroom
- This could also be implemented with the carpool parking slots in front of Placer Hall, next to Sage Hall, etc.

Students this can assist:

- Commuter students
- Students with financial burdens
