Early Alert Systems

Advocate for the implementation of an Early Alert System, first with high courses that have high Drop/Fail/Withdraw rates

- Faculty identify students who are struggling with their academics
 - Missing important assignments
 - Missing multiples lectures
 - Performing low on high stake exams/assignments
- Academic Advising would intervene with referrals to advising, tutoring, etc.



Safe Parking

Encourage the implementation of a Safe Parking Program that will allow commuter students to park overnight and safely sleep in their cars on campus

Conversations with UPD are in progress to understand the feasibility

Student Parents

Advocate for the implementation of Changing Stations in restrooms on campus

Advocate for the implementation of Lactation Rooms & Changing Station in highly populated areas on campus

Self-Certify (Basic Needs Grant)

Advocate for increase awareness outreach for Student Parent Priority Registration (as granted by CA legislation)




Accessibility & Accommodations

Advocate for the campus to provide assessments that are required by students to certify their disability accommodations.

Advocate for financial support to students who don't have insurance and have barriers to receiving these assessments.

Advocate for making the campus more accessible to students with disabilities.

- Updating entrances/doors to be accessible
- Upgrade elevator lifts in bell tower that currently require an additional person to help click the lift button



GO CI App

Encourage the implementation of community (student) interaction such as a messaging feed, similar to SJSU's app

Suggested additions:

- Message Feeds
- Event Posting
- Sharing local rooms for rent, commuting, etc.



Student Success Tools

Encourage an expansion of outreach for Student Success Tools
