# What is Lobby Corps responsibilities?

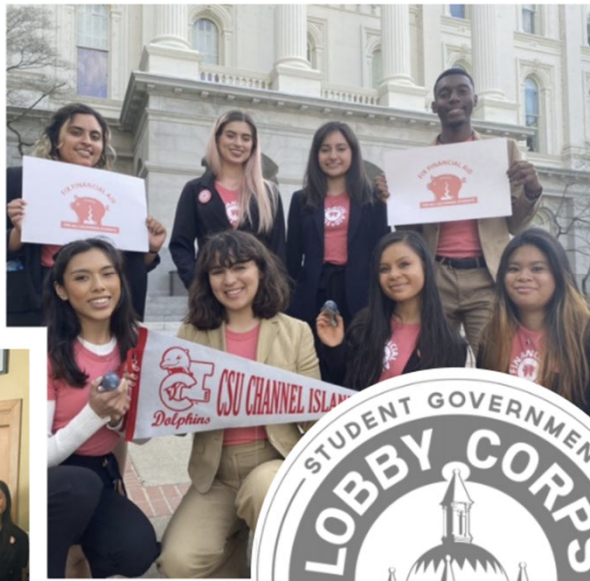


Lobby Corps is responsible for:

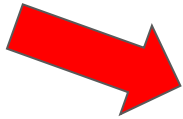








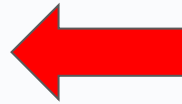

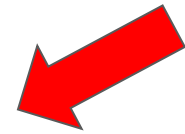
