  - a. *N. Sarmiento*: Reminded Senate that with students voicing concern over start times for courses next semester, a survey went out a couple semesters ago to students regarding class start times where feedback was given.

      - i. M. Vargas- Senator of Sustainability and Technology
        - 1. Attended CHESS over the previous weekend and will lead a discussion later in the meeting.
      - ii. A. Pogosian- Senator of Commuters and Transportation
        - Went to CHESS over the previous weekend, attended UPAC where they talked about mountain lion, police presence on campus, as well as parking and transportation concerns.

a. Senator Pogosian yielded to Advisor Block-Weiss, who clarified that the concern regarding police presence was brought forth from the residents of UGLEN who were unaware of the increase in patrol caused by the mountain lion.
