RESOLUTION

To enhance the CSU Channel Islands Student Government Senate Meeting's efficiency by waiving the Robert's Rules of Order discussion limit of two turns per senator.

Whereas, Student Government finds this to be highly inefficient for the current size of Student Government; and

Whereas, Student Government recognizes that only speaking twice during a discussion can severely hinder the operations in Student Government Senate meetings; and

Whereas, limiting discussion lowers the quality of discussion, and prevents ideas from coming to Student Government as a whole, which hurts essence of discussions.

1 **SECTION 1. RESOLUTION.**

2 *Resolved*, we at Student Government have decided to implement special rules to eliminate the speaking
3 twice rule, this provision can be suspended by a unanimous vote by the senate at any time.


4 **SEC. 2. SHORT TITLE.**


(a) SHORT TITLE.—This Act may be cited as the
