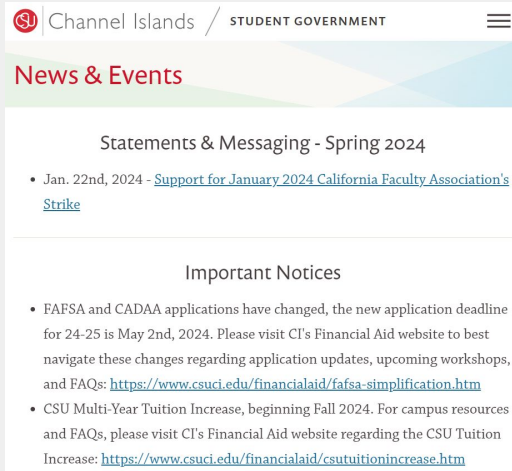

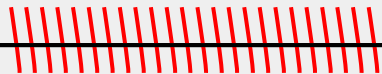
Housing Payments - 4 Installments for Fall Semesters

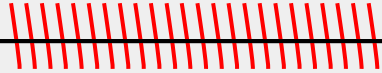
