- 4) Public Forum:
 - a. R. Fuentes: Shared that the deadline to complete the student-wide Title IX training was last Friday, October 14th, and that any student who did not complete it received a hold on their account so they will not be able to register for next semester, and registration starts in two weeks. Fuentes shared that 3,500 students (75% of the student body) did not complete the training and now has holds on their accounts. She asked that if anyone has any ideas for how to get students to complete the training or any follow-up questions, to please contact her in the Title IX office or email her at renee.fuentes@csuci.edu.
 - b. A. Taylor: Asked if the senate would be following up on the Informational Item that she and C. Briggs shared with the senate on October 5th regarding the UPD budget. Vice President Garnica shared that

a representative from UPD will tentatively be giving a presentation to the senate during next week's senate meeting.

i. A. Taylor shared the following information with the Senate:

1. Under the FOIA - Freedom of Information Act and Public Record Act Request, SQE requested a breakdown of CI UPD's yearly budget. UPD had 10 days to respond according to these acts.
2. On the tenth day, we received a follow-up question clarifying whether or not we truly meant to request the budget from all the fiscal years we sent in our request.
3. On the 11th day, before we responded, they denied our request.

ii. Timeline:

1. Public Records Access Coordinator received on September 26th.
2. Clarification response receive by us October 5th, 2022 (10th day).
3. Denial to our request received by us October 6th, 2022 (11th day).
 - a. Sent by Paula Robertson stating that there is confidential information on the budget that cannot be shared with the public.

iii. Previous requests by SQE:

1. February 11, 2022 PRA request received by public access coordinator.
2. Sent not by us, but by a CI faculty (on our behalf), Jonathan Caravello, philosophy faculty, CFA exec. board member at large.
3. February 21, 2022, he received a denial to request stating that there is confidential information on the budget that cannot be shared with the public.
4. February 24th, PRA request received by public access coordinator, Dana Baker, CI faculty, CFA exec board president, Head of political science department, Head of global studies department (Obviously "higher status" than students, and even faculty member).
5. Budget received within days, no opposition.

iv. A. Taylor stated that there should never be "confidential" information on the UPD budget. It is required by law to be accessible by the public (yes, even students).

c. A. Taylor shared that she and C. Briggs have been aware of the Title IX training brought up by R. Fuentes and have sent an email on October 10th to the Title IX office requesting a meeting to discuss Title IX office's services, however they have not yet received a response.

i. A. Taylor asked for assistance from the senate in the process of setting up a meeting with the Title IX office.
