- b. DISCUSSION ITEM: CI Rebranding Discussion (*E. Pehlivan, N. Gill*) [Time Certain: 9:30 AM]

1. Presentation provided on CSUCI's institutional brand development and readiness for a potential rebrand.
2. Significant effort has been made to identify and redefine the university's brand within the region.
3. They want to assess whether the university is prepared for institutional and visual rebranding.
4. The goal of the rebrand is to increase recognition, familiarity, and overall awareness.
5. Research has been done as well as surveys have been sent to students that focus on whether branding elements resonate and align with the institution.

i. Discussion:

- ii. (C. Pelletier) Yielded time: if it was open to student involvement, what delay would it cause, potential delays, and continuity.

- iii. (Nancy Gill): Discussed options to either move forward with campus engagement or explore alternative approaches.
 - iv. (R. Banda) Chair: Asked how the current logo is perceived.
 - v. (Nancy Gill): Noted concerns about changes to the spirit logo and explained that this is normal due to familiarity.
 - vi. (Nancy Gill): Noted that they needed to define spirit and allow time for feedback and input.
 - vii. (C. Pelletier) Yielded time: Asked about the project timeline and budget.
 - viii. (H. Alatorre) Yielded time: Asked about the expected role of student government in supporting, resolving, or voting on the proposal.
 - ix. (E. Pehlivan): Clarified that they are open to any feedback from student government.
 - x. (C. Pelletier) Yielded time: Asked whether the website redesign and logo updates are connected.
 - xi. (Nancy Gill): They both reflected on each other, and the new website would have the new elements if approved.
- c. DISCUSSION ITEM: Overview of CSSA Sponsored Bills (*E. Conde, C. Pelletier, R. Banda*)
- 1. Explained key dates and provided an overview of the various bills and how they will look for different students.
 - 2. Discussed the different bills that CSSA will support and co-sponsor across the CSU, and students will advocate for the five selected bills.
