starting the Friday before the conference, welcome guests, and carry out logistical tasks to make sure the event runs smoothly. We complete participation request forms, catering plans, determine menu and cost, create a checklist of attendees names, design a floor plan for setup, and design name tags and a welcome banner. There will also have to be communication with Police on campus to ensure that our guests are not ticketed for parking violations during their stay at CI. David explains that he would like to put together a task force of SG officers to handle these issues, and asks for a show of hands to gauge the interest of the Senate in this idea.

ii. Student Government Outreach- Steven Jordan-

2. Steven spoke about SG outreach. The idea behind this is to increase student involvement in clubs and organizations on campus, and to incentivize the senators to get out and meet new people on around CI. Steven suggested the idea of a point system (ten points for Seal Center involvement, fifteen for attending club/organization meetings, etc.), with the winner earning a free meal from Steven. This is just a suggestion; the plan will be figured out within the next week.

b. Discussion:

i. Skateboarding Task Force- David Ashley-

1. David will be putting together a team to work on changing the CI skateboarding policy. Senator Cervi volunteered to take lead on this issue, and expressed her desires to develop cooperation with clubs and students. Senator Wilson asked if there a meeting set up where we would find out if we were amending the policy on alternate transportation or if we were writing it; David: The policy already exists, we would be looking to amend it. Senator Cervi requested a meeting to learn about the process of changing policy; David: Policies are changed through a meeting of the President's Planning and Policy Council.

ii. Senator Vacancy- Steven Jordan-

2. Steven spoke on the recent resignation of Zein Alamaddene from the Student Government Senate. Student Government by laws state that any senator has right to resign from office, and that the President has 30 days to appoint new senator, who must be approved by 2/3 majority of the Senate. JanaSenator Plat stated that she was aware of multiple transfer students who were interested in becoming involved with Student Government, and that she would reach out to them.

c. Action Items

i. IAC Chair- Vanessa Bahena-

1. The Internal affairs Committee is in charge primarily of rewriting by laws and handling internal investigations into the Senate. Steven would like to appoint Senator Bahena to the chair position due to her extensive involvement throughout campus and her location in Housing. Senator Bahena stated that she has already begun discussing with fellow Senators how to approach her

new role, should she be appointed. A discussion was held while Senator Bahena left the room. The Senator inquired into what the roles of the IAC Chair and committee members would be. Senator Cervi asked for an explanation of what the IAC is and does. Senator Plat inquired into whether or not the IAC was involved in SG elections. David and Steven explained that they would only handle internal investigations in cases of gross violation of the bylaws by Student Government officers, and that the IAC would be in charge of implementing new processes and procedures, and rewriting bylaws if necessary. Steven sought a motion to appoint Senator Bahena. Motion: Senator Vinas; Second: Senator Walters. Voted in unanimously.

ii. IAC Members- Chelsea Vinas and Rhonna Horney-

2. Steven explained his decision to appoint Senator Vinas and Senator Horney to be IAC Committee members based on their abilities to cooperate as a team and because of their common location making possible urgent meetings more accessible. Senator Horney expressed her eagerness to work as a team on this committee. Discussion was held while Senator Vinas and Senator Horney left the room. Senator Cervi wondered whether or not it was typical for Senators to serve on the committee; David: Yes, it's a Senate committee comprised of Senators. Ben asked if these were appointments or selections by the committee chair; Steven: They are nominated appointments who must be approved. Vote was held. Seven: yes; one: no. The motion carried; Senator Vinas and Senator Horney were appointed to the IAC Committee.

 - i. President – David Ashley- David alerted the Senate to the possibility of campus-wide student referendum on category II fee increases. He also stated that he is preparing training materials for all committee members not on the Student Fee Advisory Committee. He is also working on scheduling the first Executive Committee meeting.

 - i. Steven would like to see the creation of Constituency Reports for Senators. He is also working on the office hour template. Steven will be meeting with the Senators individually in the coming week. He and David will also be conducting a search to fill the vacant Senate position.

 1. Senator Bahena is working on creating opt out sheets for door to door voter registration in Housing. She also announced that club tabling has been initiated in housing and that SG will be involved in helping. Senator Bahena also attended the latest RHA meetings.
