i. President Report (*A. Fox*)

1. The Lobby Coprs application deadline was extended to Sunday February 9<sup>th</sup> at 11:59 PM
2. Lobby Corps is a paid for trip by the student category 2 fees, the trip is to Sacramento
3. The next cooking cal fresh is being planned and will most likely be a Mardi Gras theme on March 4<sup>th</sup>
4. Wants everyone to spread the word about student government elections
5. The Ebony Ball is taking place on February 21<sup>st</sup>
6. The event is a collaboration between Student Government, the Black Student Union, and the Black Cultural Center
7. It is a semi formal event, with a live DJ, food, a photo booth and students can nominate students for faculty for a special recognition event

i. Advisor Block-Weiss

3. 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Cosmos of Love will be happening on Thursday at 8:30 PM and is a semi formal event
4. For the first time will be selling alcohol to those 21+
5. Election marketing will be going out early and will launch this week
6. Encourages everyone to run in this year’s election
7. Tells everyone that if they are interested in attending the election council meeting that it is open to the public

8) New Business:

- a. INFORMATION ITEM: Category II Fees (A. Fox)
  - i. President Fox: Category 2 fees are a mandatory student fee

- ii. Category 2 fees include the rec fee, the ASI fee, the caps fee, health service fee, orientation fee, the in-structurally related activity fee (IRA), material services facilities and technology fee
- iii. These fees fund essential services in campus
- iv. CSUCI has the lowest Category 2 fees out of all the CSUs by a large margin
- v. Explains that these fees haven't been raised in 10 years, and 10 years ago there was higher enrollment and lower cost of goods
- vi. Explains that our services have also expanded since then
- vii. The Student Fee Advisory Committee has been looking at raising these fees to ensure that our campus programs can remain maintained
- viii. Look out for the tabling that is teaching students about what the category 2 fees are
- ix. Explains that we need to inform the student body of what Category 2 fees are and what services they cover as most students may not know
- x. Senator Davis: Wondering how the Gateway building was funded as we are in a deficit and needing to make cuts
- xi. President Fox: Explains that to his knowledge the building was fully funded by a donor but agrees about how the optics of it are not great
- xii. Advisor Block-Weiss: Explains that it's not one pot of money that fund the whole school there are many different categories of fees that fund the different projects and operations of campus
- xiii. President Fox: Asks everyone to stay informed about this topic so as Student Government we can properly inform the student body of these fees

- d. President Fox: Tells Senator Soriano that if we are going to pursue the discussion item, we should invite the relevant parties
- e. Senator Fox: Explains that the idea of customizations is great but maybe shouldn't be able to opt out entirely
- f. Senator Soriano: Expresses distaste for the current state of the cafeteria
- g. Advisor Block-Weiss: Explains that this needs to be tabled as a discussion item for next week
